



Cranberry Spey:

Materials Needed:

Hook: Up Eye salmon hook, size 2 though 1/0

Tail: A piece of saltwater mirage fringe, or some pearl flash from an Easter basket.

Rear 2/3 of Body: Remnant of tail material, ribbed with thread

Front 1/3 of body: peacock ice dub with the hackle wound through it

Hackle: Large black or grey spey hackle. Blue eared pheasant works great as does dyed mallard flank

Flash: Cranberry Holographic flashabou, tied above and below the hook

Comment: This is a great steelhead pattern, and is especially effective in the months of October and November in West Michigan.
